NOTIFICATION

Applications are invited for admission to the **Four Year Under Graduate Programmes and B.Voc. Under Graduate Programmes** in the affiliated Arts & Science Colleges of University of Calicut for the academic year 2026-27 except those Under Graduate Programmes admission to which is based on entrance examinations and Programmes conducted in Autonomous Colleges.

CUFYUGP shall have three Broad Pathways, (a) 3-year UG Degree, (b) 4-year UG Degree (Honours), and (c) 4-year UG Degree (Honours with Research). Students who choose to exit after 3 years shall be awarded UG Degree in their respective Major Discipline after the successful completion of the required minimum of courses of total 133 credits. A four-year UG Degree (Honours) in the Major Discipline shall be awarded to those who complete the CUFYUGP with a specific number of courses of total 177 credits, including 8 credits from an optional graduate project /dissertation in their Major/ allied discipline. Honours students who have not undertaken their graduate project shall do two additional courses in the Major discipline, each comprising four credits. Students who aspire to pursue research as a career may opt for Honours with Research stream in the fourth year. A four-year UG Degree (Honours with Research) in the Major Discipline shall be awarded to those who complete the CUFYUGP with a specific number of courses of total 177 credits, including 12 credits from a mandatory graduate research project /dissertation in their Major discipline.

The Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) programmes offered by the University of Calicut is designed from 2025-26 academic year onwards to equip students with industry-relevant practical skills and theoretical knowledge, in alignment with the National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF). By integrating features of the Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) and emphasising vocational education, this three-year programme—along with an optional one-year apprenticeship embedded PG diploma, equivalent to the Honours degree programme ensures employability, lifelong learning, and both horizontal and vertical mobility through structured pathways. It provides four exit options: Upon completing two semesters, students receive an Undergraduate Certificate (NSQF Level 4.5); after four semesters, an Undergraduate Diploma (NSQF Level 5.0); after six semesters, a B.Voc. Degree (NSQF Level 5.5); and after eight semesters, a PG Diploma or Honours Degree (NSQF Level 6.0). Candidates should go through the FYUGP prospectus for Centralised Admission Process and B.Voc Regulations available in the website carefully before entering the registration page.

I. All candidates seeking admission to the under graduate programmes irrespective of the Quota (General Merit/ Reservation/ Sports/ Persons with Disabilities/ Community/ Management/Inmates of Juvenile Justice Home/Trans-gender etc.) should compulsorily register through Centralised Admission Process (CAP).

Candidates should go through the prospectus for Centralised Admission Process available in the

website carefully before entering the registration page.
